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starving ghosts anguished farmers and grieving mothers floating heads gaunt bodies and masses of bodily fluids such are the visceral sensations exaggerated affects and suffering subjects that characterized leftist korean cultural production in the 1920s and 1930s in popular fiction print cartoons reportage and other emergent forms of mass culture scenes detailing the spectacular bodily harms endured by figures like migrant workers tenant farmers and everyday families proliferated yet at the time such representations were criticized as excessively grotesque and insufficiently political by leftist intellectuals and they have subsequently been overlooked by scholars in favor of socialist realism and its dynamic proletarian heroes the sensational proletarian by contrast focuses on these textual and visual representations to tell the story of how new affects and everyday experiences introduced by imperial capitalism and colonial modernity were mediated through the lower class body kimberly chung traces the emergence of the sensational proletarian as a central figure of colonial korean print culture and reads its varied manifestations as emblematic of korean efforts not only to grapple with modernity imperialism and capitalism but to do so using the new political ideology and imaginary of marxism this book brings to light the centrality of sensational cultures in the development of class politics in korea an integral relationship that continues throughout modern and contemporary korean cultural history

this wide ranging companion provides a vital overview of modern chinese literature in different geopolitical areas from the 1840s to now it reviews major accomplishments of chinese literary scholarship published in chinese and english and brings attention to previously neglected important areas offers the most thorough and concise coverage of modern chinese literature to date drawing attention to previously neglected areas such as late qing sinophone and ethnic minority literature several chapters explore literature in relation to sinophone geopolitics regional culture urban culture visual culture print media and new media the introduction and two chapters furnish overviews of the institutional development of modern chinese literature in chinese and english scholarship since the mid twentieth century contributions from leading literary scholars in mainland china and hong kong

add their voices to international scholarship

considering how culturally indispensable digital technology is today it is ironic that computer generated art was attacked when it burst onto the scene in the early 1960s in fact no other twentieth century art form has elicited such a negative and hostile response when the machine made art examines the cultural and critical response to computer art or what we refer to today as digital art tracing the heated debates between art and science the societal anxiety over nascent computer technology and the myths and philosophies surrounding digital computation taylor is able to identify the destabilizing forces that shape and eventually fragment the computer art movement

this book contains a new translation of the second half of the pedagogy of the adolescent by the renowned soviet thinker educator and teacher l s vygotsky it was a correspondence course written by vygotsky for teachers across the soviet union and it constitutes the longest work published in his lifetime four chapters have never been translated before and appear here for the very first time with this volume vygotsky concludes the sustained argument he commenced in vol 3 pedagogy of the adolescent i pedagogy in the transitional age establishing the borders of pedagogy the nature of the transition between childhood and adulthood and the concrete nature of the distinction between the lower psychological functions we largely have in common with animals and those that are specific to fully social humans in this volume vygotsky puts flesh on the skeleton of his working hypothesis concerning the interests and the development of concepts in the psychology of the adolescent he then frames concepts as a special case of developing higher psychological functions and demonstrates the roots of that development in the social environment many of the problems vygotsky broaches in these new chapters the choice of a profession the initiation of the adolescent into working life are still of immediate not to say urgent relevance today the volume concludes with a remarkable vision of a society where production is organized for the producers that still seems far ahead of its time and still ahead of our own

consisting of an introduction and ten chapters exclusionary empire examines the transfer of english traditions of liberty and the

rule of law overseas from 1600 to 1900 each chapter is written by a noted specialist and focuses on a particular area of the settler empire colonial north america the west indies ireland the early united states canada australia new zealand and south africa and on one non settler colony india the book examines the ways in which the polities in each of these areas incorporated these traditions paying particular attention to the extent to which these traditions were confined to the independent white male segments of society and denied to most others this collection will be invaluable to all those interested in the history of colonialism european expansion the development of empire the role of cultural inheritance in those histories and the confinement of access to that inheritance to people of european descent

the gospel of the christ is a clear biblical reply to the question of what a person must believe about jesus christ to possess eternal life while christianity has historically maintained that faith in jesus christ is essential for everlasting life this raises the vital question what is the necessary content of this faith written against the backdrop of the controversy within free grace circles over the crossless gospel and the contents of saving faith thomas stegall goes well beyond a carefully documented analysis of his own movement the gospel of the christ provides a systematic exegetically based treatment of biblical teaching on the subject of the gospel and the meaning of the title the christ the end result is a comprehensive biblical and theological study of jesus christ s person and work in the contents of saving faith

china s transformation from a poor and underdeveloped country into a global market power has profoundly altered its socioeconomic power relations with the other countries in the greater china region namely taiwan and hong kong indeed this economic shift has resulted in the massive flow of capital and people from taiwan as well as hong kong to china to seek business opportunities and new lifestyles these flows have in turn completely transformed longstanding borderlines in the region this book examines the transformation of taiwan and hong kong s socioeconomic relationships with china as their economies have become more deeply integrated into greater china across three key sections it explores the impact of increasing social interaction and the shrinking of existing borderlines to ask whether these changes will bring about a convergence of identity among the people involved production examines how investments from taiwan and hong kong to china have transformed production networks community explores the impact of cross boundary mobility and the integration of migrants into chinese communities and finally identity engages with what is one of the most important issues in contemporary taiwanese society border crossing in greater china contributes not only to theoretical debates on border crossing issues but also provides valuable insights on the practical concerns regarding social and political integration and tensions in the region as such it will be of great interest to students and scholars of taiwan studies chinese studies chinese society and chinese economics

presented a distinctive approach to the key issues which confront the societies of the twentieth and twenty first centuries for some this work will be a textbook for others an indispensable sourcebook of sociological concepts and for most a way of opening our eyes to new dimensions in our understanding of the great ideas and theories of sociology

although the concept of policy networks is now well established in the field most research has to content itself with description and analysis of their contribution to policy failure this book goes further it accepts policy networks as a fundamental characteristic of modern societies and presents an overview of the strategies for the management of these networks as well as illustrating the various strategies for intervention

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
